

Worksheet 5-1: Template to monitor energy plan projects, with definitions

Vision: The community energy committee's vision.

General targets: The community energy committee's general targets.

Project: The name of the project, as identified in the action plan.

Example: Do a feasibility study of run-of-river hydro.

| Tasks or actions | Results expected from each task | Indicators |
|---|---|---|
| The list of tasks you plan to carry out, to complete the project, as identified in the action plan. | The end results you expect from each task. An increase of something positive or a decrease of something negative. | Things you measure to describe results of each task. Indicators tell you what effects each task has on results of the project as a whole. |
| Example of one task: Measure water flow and drop at chosen location. | Example: More information about whether the chosen location is suitable. | Example: Number and frequency of measurements we took over one year. |

Results expected from the project: The end results you expect from the project as a whole.

Example: Good information to help decide if we have a good site for run-of-river hydro.
